The Agency response to the protests was submitted Monday to the ODRA and the attorneys. It was 156 single space pages and 4 boxes of attachments, other than that I don't know what it said due to it being protected. The attorneys are working on their response which is due by next Friday, then it's up to Judge Neall to make a recommendation.

The response to the letter I sent to Lockheed Martin just arrived in the office and I'll be sending a copy of that along with this update.

Mike Sheldon New England Regional Director, set up a press conference yesterday outside Bridgeport AFSS on airport property and it went very well. We now have every representative in Connecticut signed on to the bills in both the house and senate from both sides of the aisle. Our support for this language is growing each day, so keep doing what you're doing out there.

Age Discrimination Suit - The paperwork requesting an injunction should be complete soon and submitted to the court for ruling to stop this whole process until the EEOC lawsuit is ruled on. We are hoping for a ruling prior to July 4th.

Thanks to all of you who have filled out forms and helped collect data over the past weeks. It will become very evident what we are doing once the data is compiled and released.
