I have been asked to speak at a couple of seminars in the past month, one was at an A-76 symposium and the other was at an ATCA seminar last week. The first one was worth the time because I had the pleasure of meeting one of the Directors of GAO (Government Accountability Office) and after a couple of emails, we set up a meeting for yesterday afternoon.
